❖ 成績評価 Grading System			
<p>※Evaluation: Students will be evaluated on the preparation for each lesson, their participation in class discussions, their weekly "show and tell" activity, four different presentations and weekly vocabulary quizzes.</p> <p>Class Participation: There is the possibility of 12 participation points for every class. If you come to class and actively participate in the activities in English you can get 12 points based on the Class Participation Grading Scale. (This is available on the Moodle course.) If you come to class and sleep, don't participate or speak a lot of Japanese you will get fewer points. If your speaking Japanese becomes disruptive I will ask you to leave. Class will start on time, but you can still enter the room 10 minutes after it starts, but at 11 minutes you will be marked absent and not allowed into the room. My watch is set to NHK time not Chikudai time.</p>			

Homework:Homework will be a combination of reading and presentation preparation. All of the assignments will be posted to the course website. The Show & Tell and Presentations will be peer reviewed based on a rubric that will be explained in the first lesson. There are no make up assignments.

Show and Tell:The grading of the seven "Show and Tell" activity will be based on a peer evaluation rubric which will be available on the course Moodle page. Part of the evaluation will be done through peer review.

Presentations:The grading of the five presentations will be based on an evaluation rubric which will be available on the course Moodle page. Part of the evaluation will be based on peer review.
